The country, told from the county jail

PROBLEM – what issue is the character trying to solve?

Wolf needs a cup of sugar to make his granny a cake; Wolf also needs to convince the reader that he's innocent.

EVENTS

What happens in the story?

CHARACTER PERSPECTIVE

S/he is feeling.... S/he is thinking...

<p>Wolf addresses the reader and sets up the story</p>	<p>Wolf thinks he's been viewed all wrong. He feels innocent.</p>
<p>Wolf is making a cake and runs out of sugar</p>	<p>Wolf feels bad with a cold but is determined to make his granny a cake. He thinks a neighbor will lend him sugar.</p>
<p>Wolf goes to First Pig's house, blows it down, & eats the pig</p>	<p>First Pig is too scared or too smart to open the door for the wolf. Wolf doesn't mean to kill the pig with his sneeze, but since the pig's dead he thinks it's okay to eat him. He still needs sugar.</p>
<p>Wolf goes to Second Pig's house, blows it down, & eats the pig</p>	<p>Second Pig may be too scared or too smart or just too busy to open the door for the wolf. Wolf doesn't mean to kill this pig either, but again thinks it's okay to eat him. He still needs sugar.</p>
<p>Wolf goes to Third Pig's house and tries (but fails) to blow it down</p>	<p>Third Pig feels annoyed by the wolf and safe in his house. Wolf feels so mad when the pig insults his granny that he tries to break down the door.</p>

EVENTS

What happens in the story?

CHARACTER PERSPECTIVE

S/he is feeling.... S/he is thinking...

Wolf is arrested and taken to jail	Wolf thinks he's been wrongfully accused. He feels innocent.

RESOLUTION – how is the story solved?

Wolf still needs his sugar, so he did not solve that problem; it is up to the reader to decide if the Wolf is innocent.
